# Code of Conduct

 the ultimate goal of the Code is to prevent unethical conduct before it occurs

• Symbolically: the rail of a bridge to prevent you from falling off



#### In Essence:

 not to engage in any act of a dishonest, deceitful, or fraudulent nature.

• not to pursue after financial gain or other personal benefit to interfere with the exercise of sound professional judgement and practices.



 to be subject to disciplinary action for the violation of any law or regulation.

• competently and consistently discharge one's duties.



 to support efforts to effect such improvements in teaching and learning, doing research, rendering services to the public, supporting and promoting Thai tradition and culture, and other operations as quality assurance, good governance, planning to improve overall efficiency and effectiveness in the functioning of the university.



• to support policies and practices of the university which provide individual lecturers with ample opportunities for advancement and to keep uptodate for professional competence and achievement.



• to support the development, improvement, and enforcement of such regulations, and codes as will foster competence and ethical conduct on the part of all lecturers for the benefits of the students.



• not to withhold information or assistance officially requested by appropriate regulatory authorities who are investigating or prosecuting any alleged violation of the regulations governing conduct of others.



#### Authentic Lecturer
